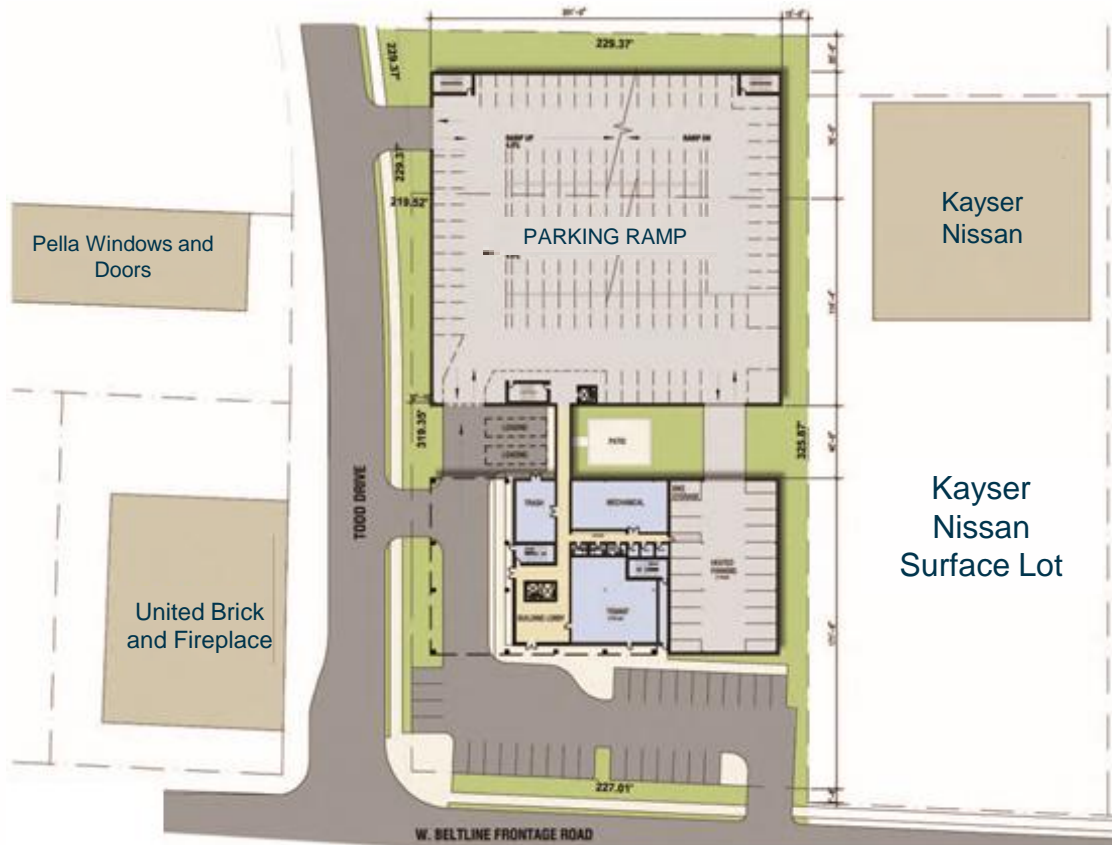

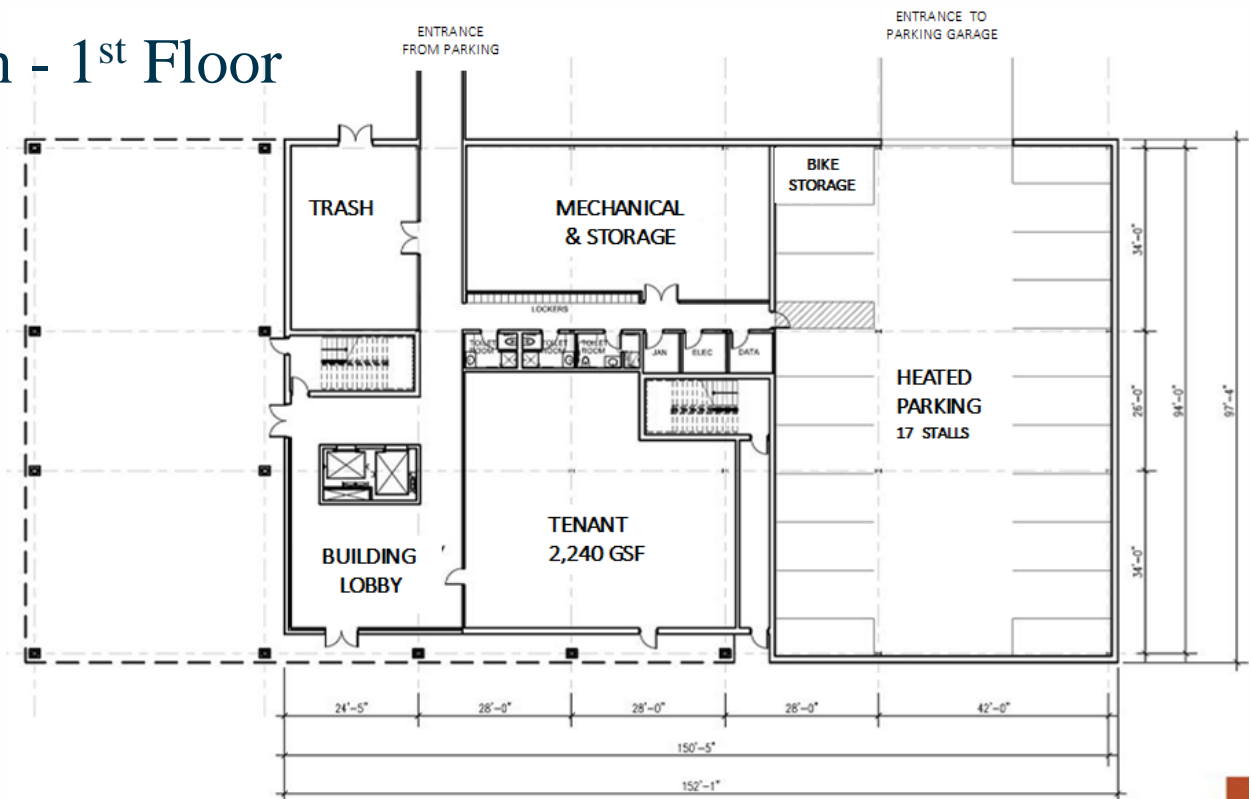

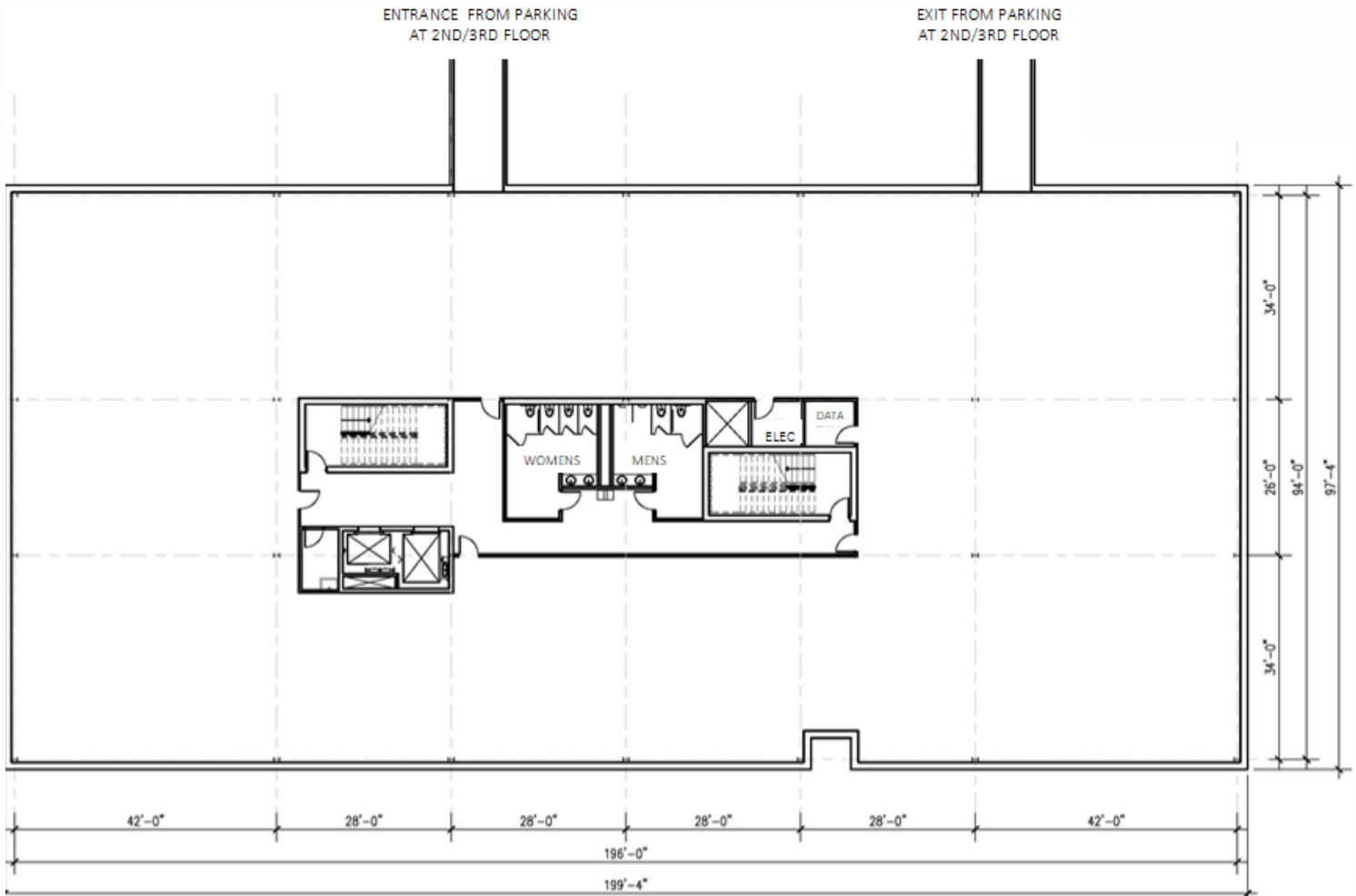

 13 information is prohibited by law (see lines 42-51).

14 (e) The duty to protect your confidentiality. Unless the law requires it, the Firm and its Agents will not disclose your
 15 confidential information or the confidential information of other parties (see lines 23-41).

16 (f) The duty to safeguard trust funds and other property held by the Firm or its Agents.

17 (g) The duty, when negotiating, to present contract proposals in an objective and unbiased manner and disclose the
 18 advantages and disadvantages of the proposals.

19 Please review this information carefully. An Agent of the Firm can answer your questions about brokerage services,
 20 but if you need legal advice, tax advice, or a professional home inspection, contact an attorney, tax advisor, or home

42 **DEFINITION OF MATERIAL ADVERSE FACTS**

 45 party, that it affects or would affect the party's decision to enter into a contract or agreement concerning a transaction
 46 or affects or would affect the party's decision about the terms of such a contract or agreement.

47 An "Adverse Fact" is defined in Wis. Stat. § 452.01(1e) as a condition or occurrence that a competent licensee
 48 generally recognizes will significantly and adversely affect the value of the property, significantly reduce the structural
 49 integrity of improvements to real estate, or present a significant health risk to occupants of the property; or information
 50 that indicates that a party to a transaction is not able to or does not intend to meet his or her obligations under a
 51 contract or agreement made concerning the transaction.
