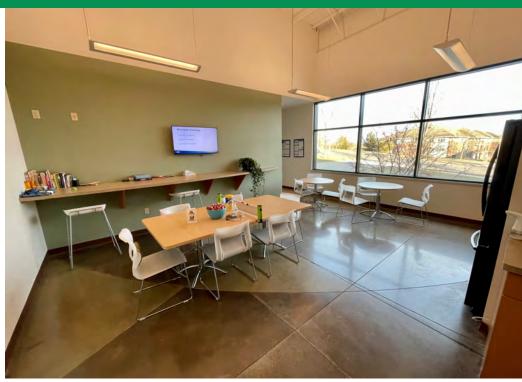

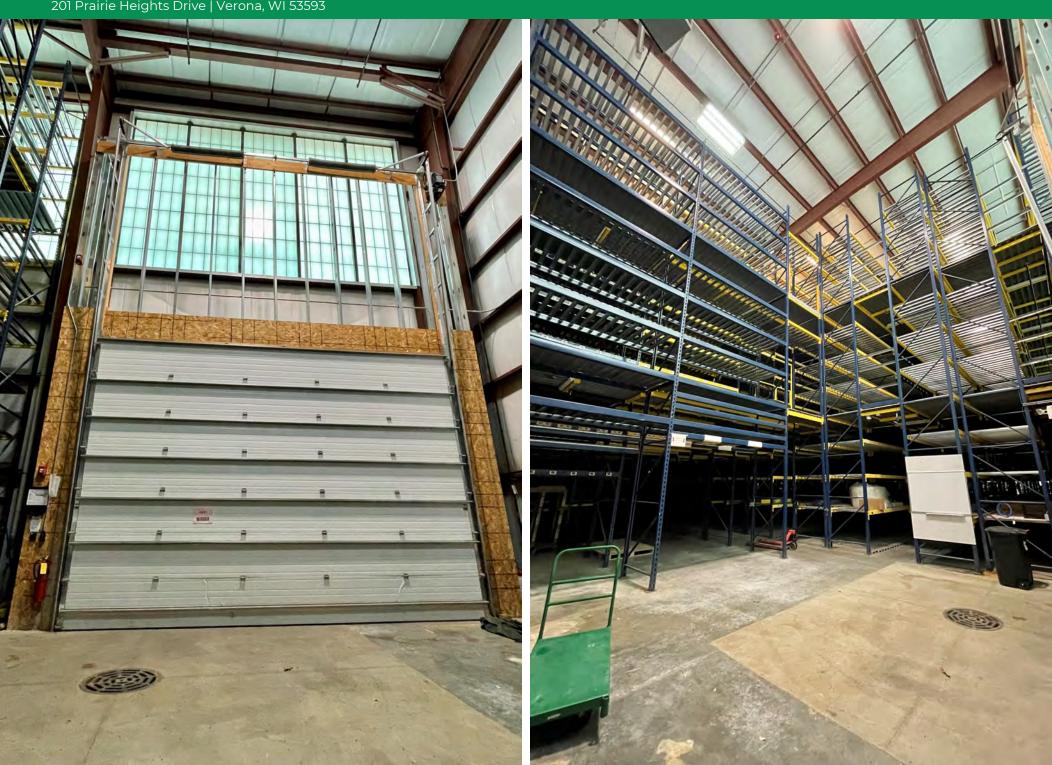








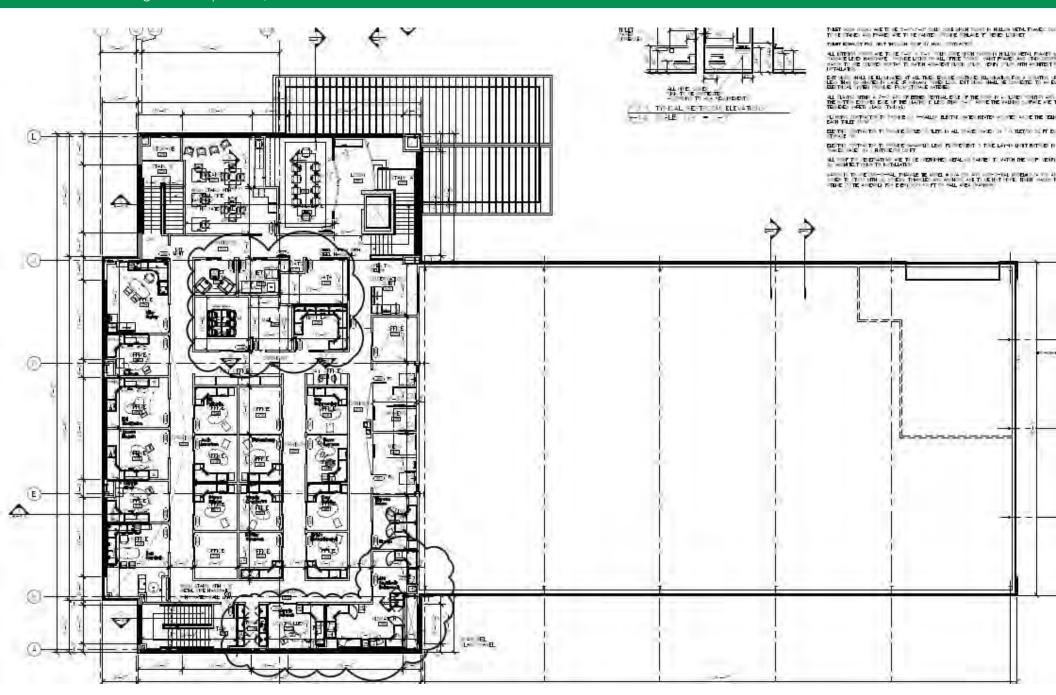

## **BUILDING PLANS - 2ND FLOOR**

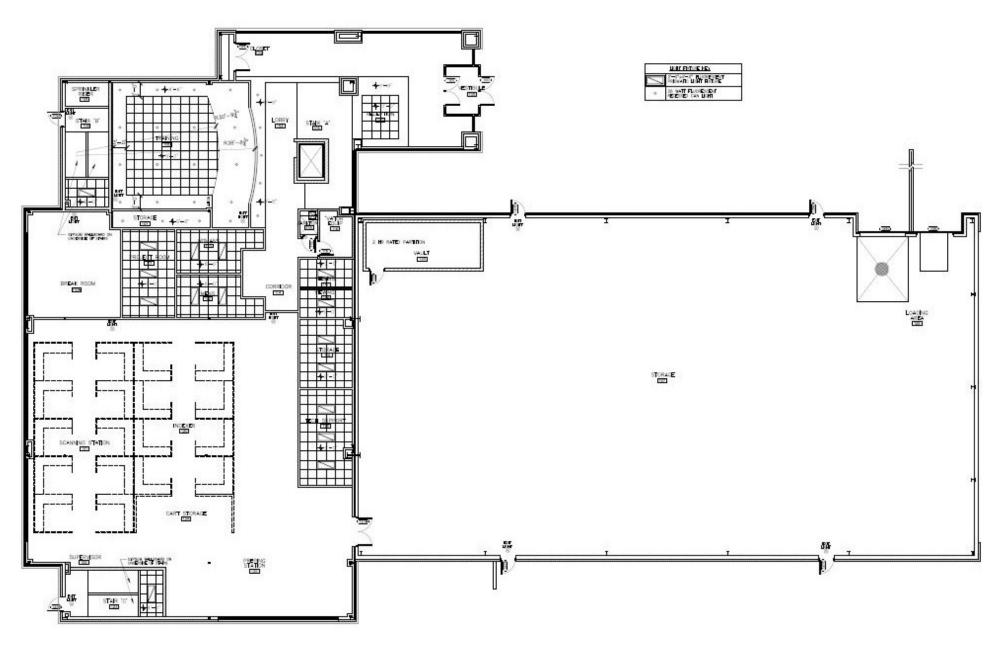

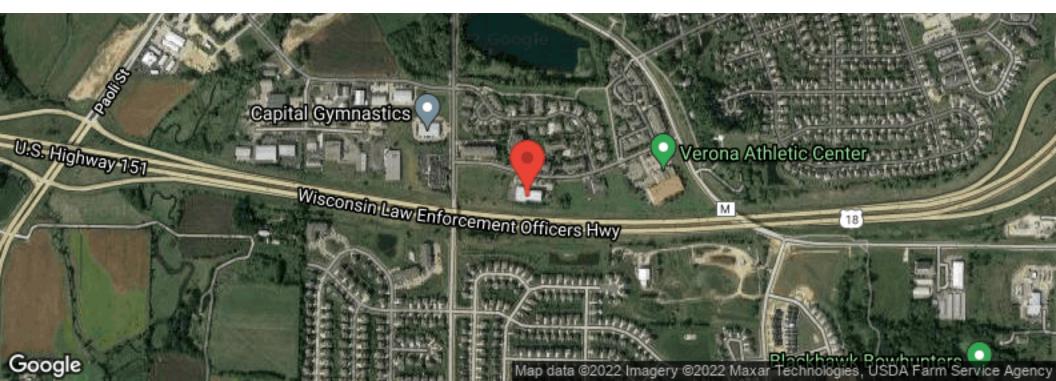






## **LOCATION MAP**
