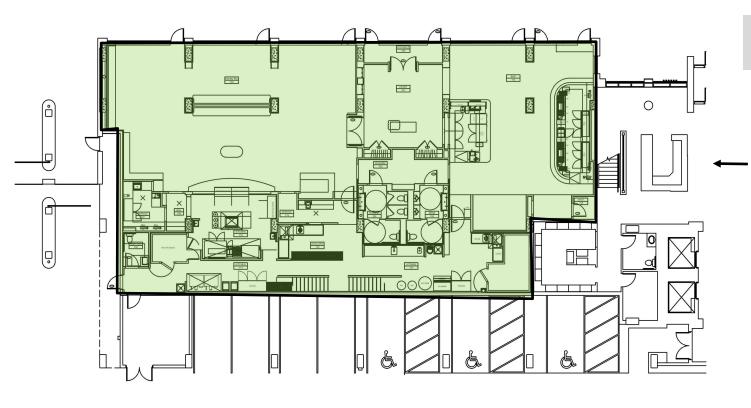






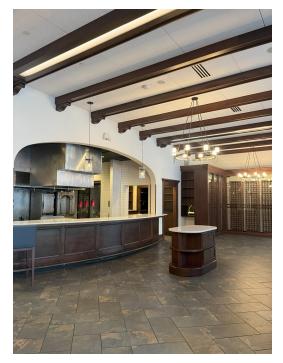
Floor Plan
