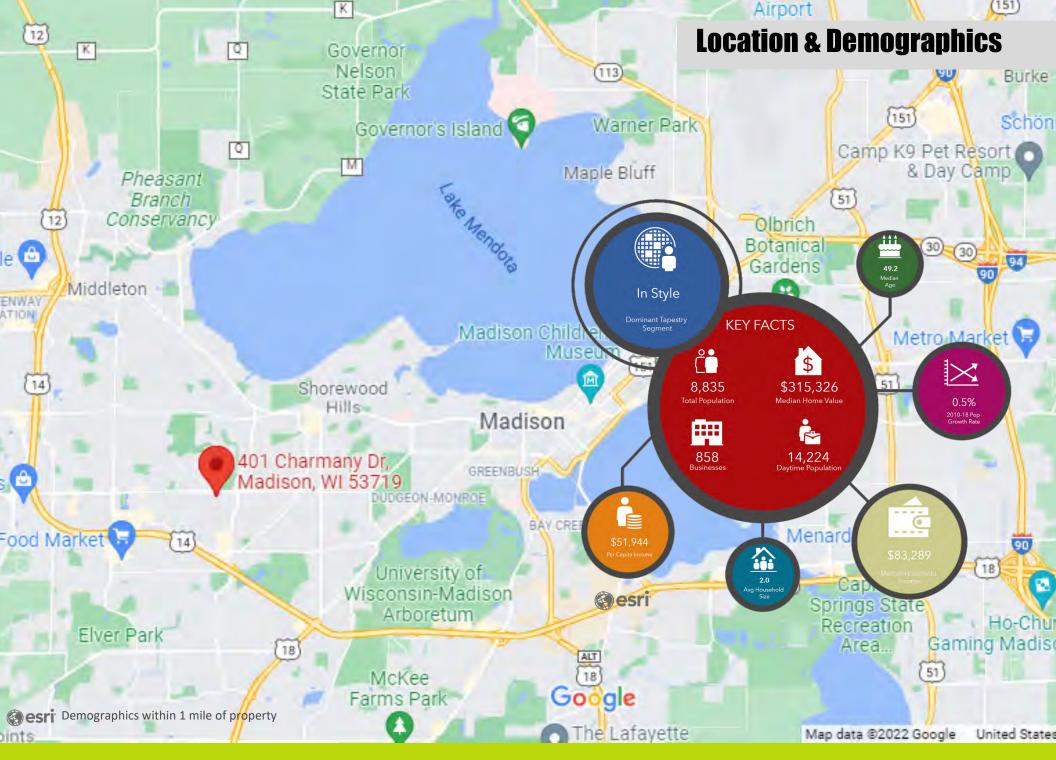

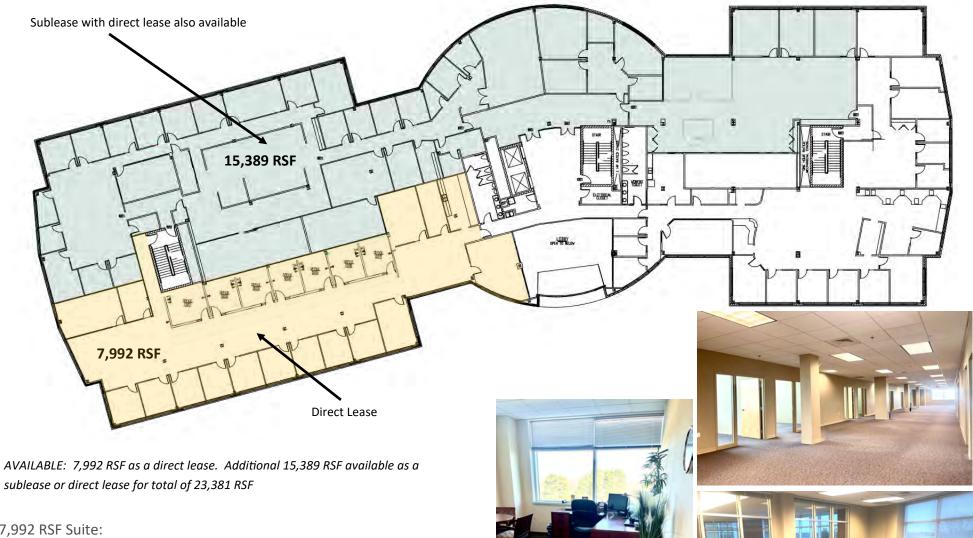








2nd Floor - Floor Plan
