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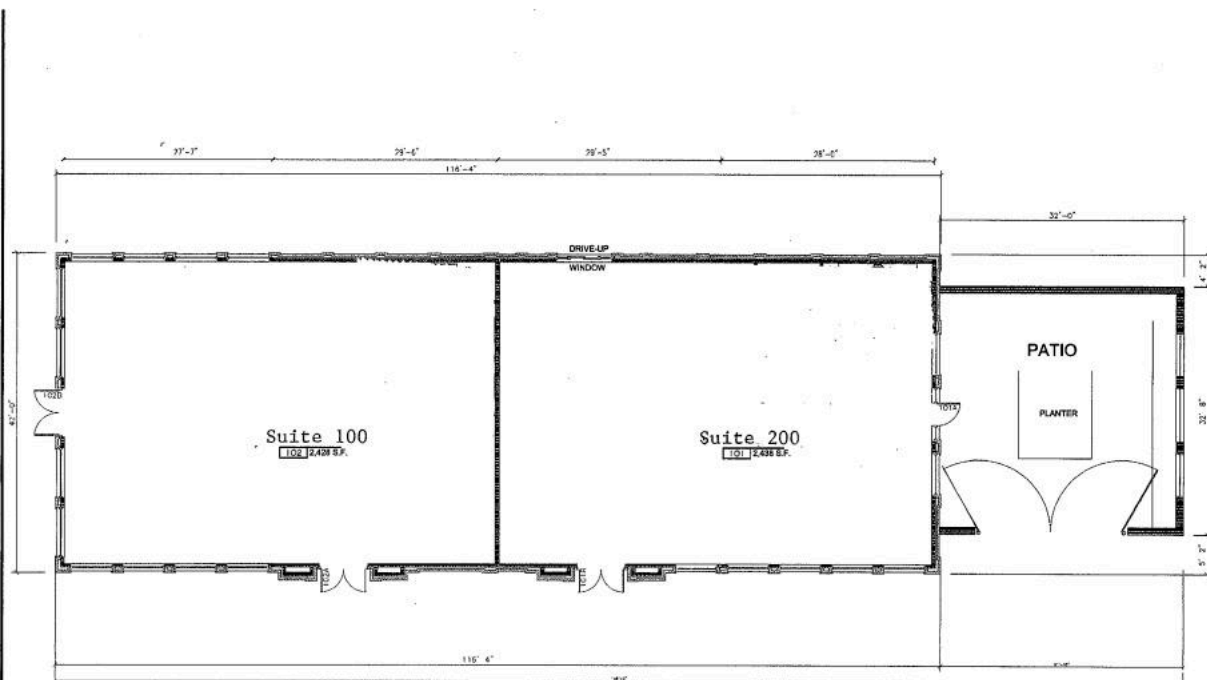
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Floor Plan — 4833 Annamark Dr

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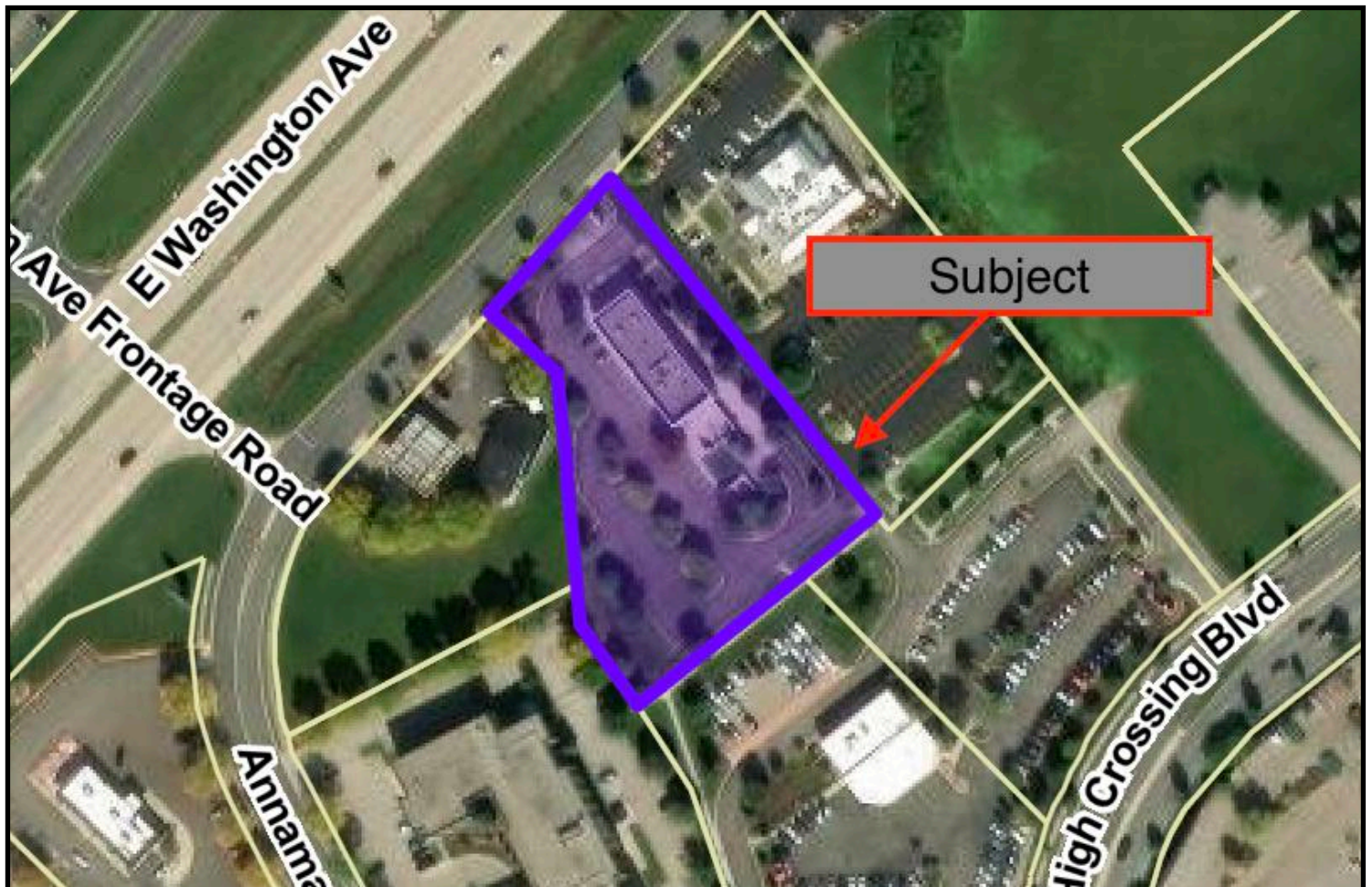

15 ■ The duty to safeguard trust funds and other property the broker holds.

16 ■ The duty, when negotiating, to present contract proposals in an objective and unbiased manner and disclose the advantages and
17 disadvantages of the proposals.
