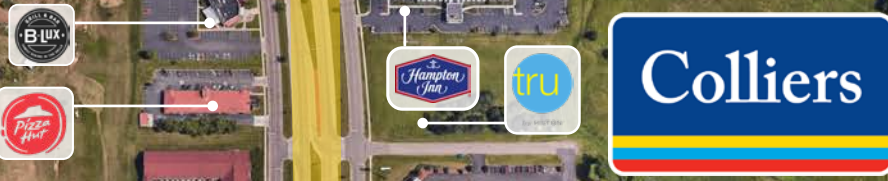

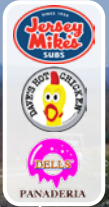

A "Material Adverse Fact" is defined in Wis.
