Located just east of Dane County Regional Airport in the Center for Industry & Commerce. Quick access to USH 51, and Interstates 90/94/39.

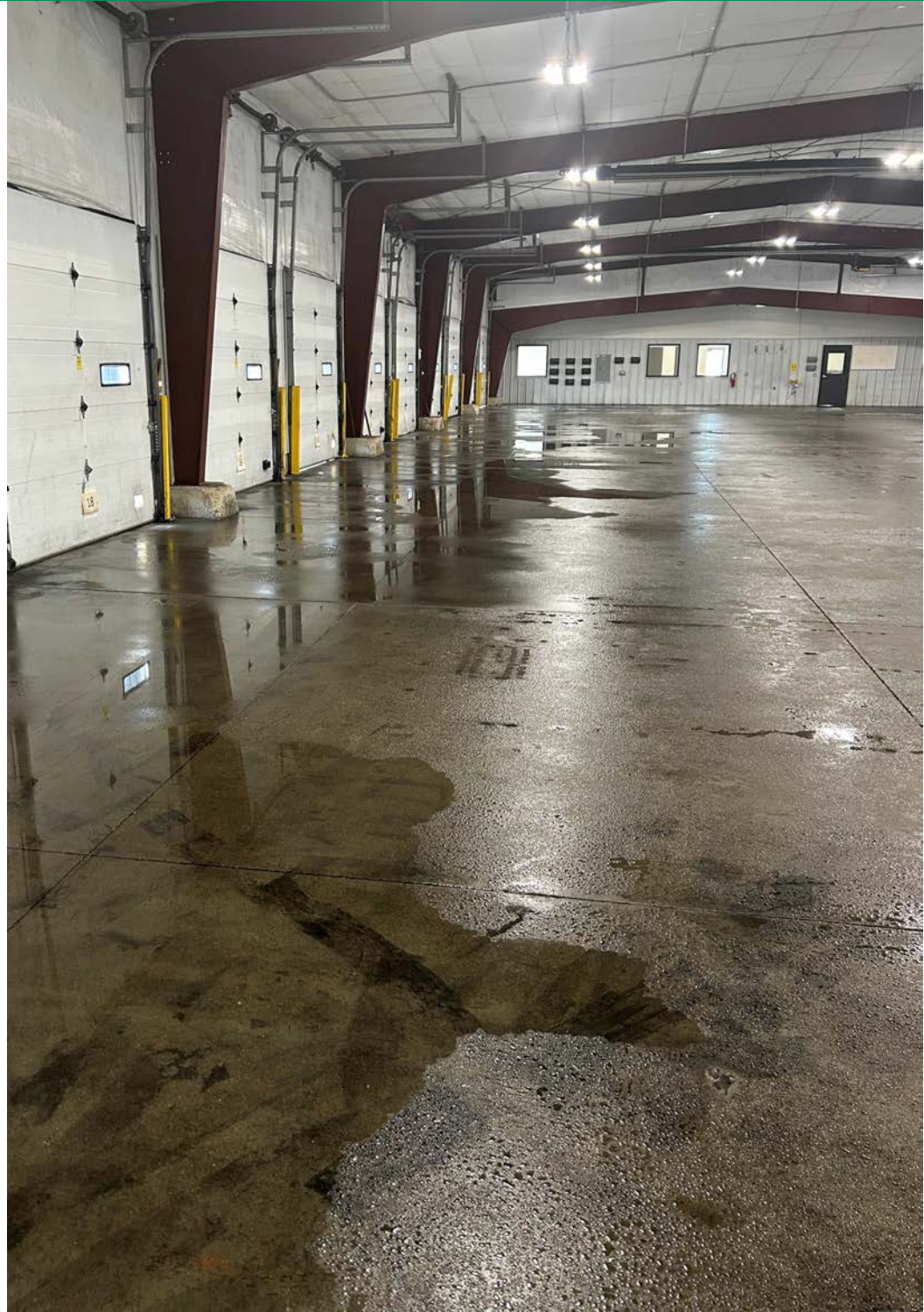

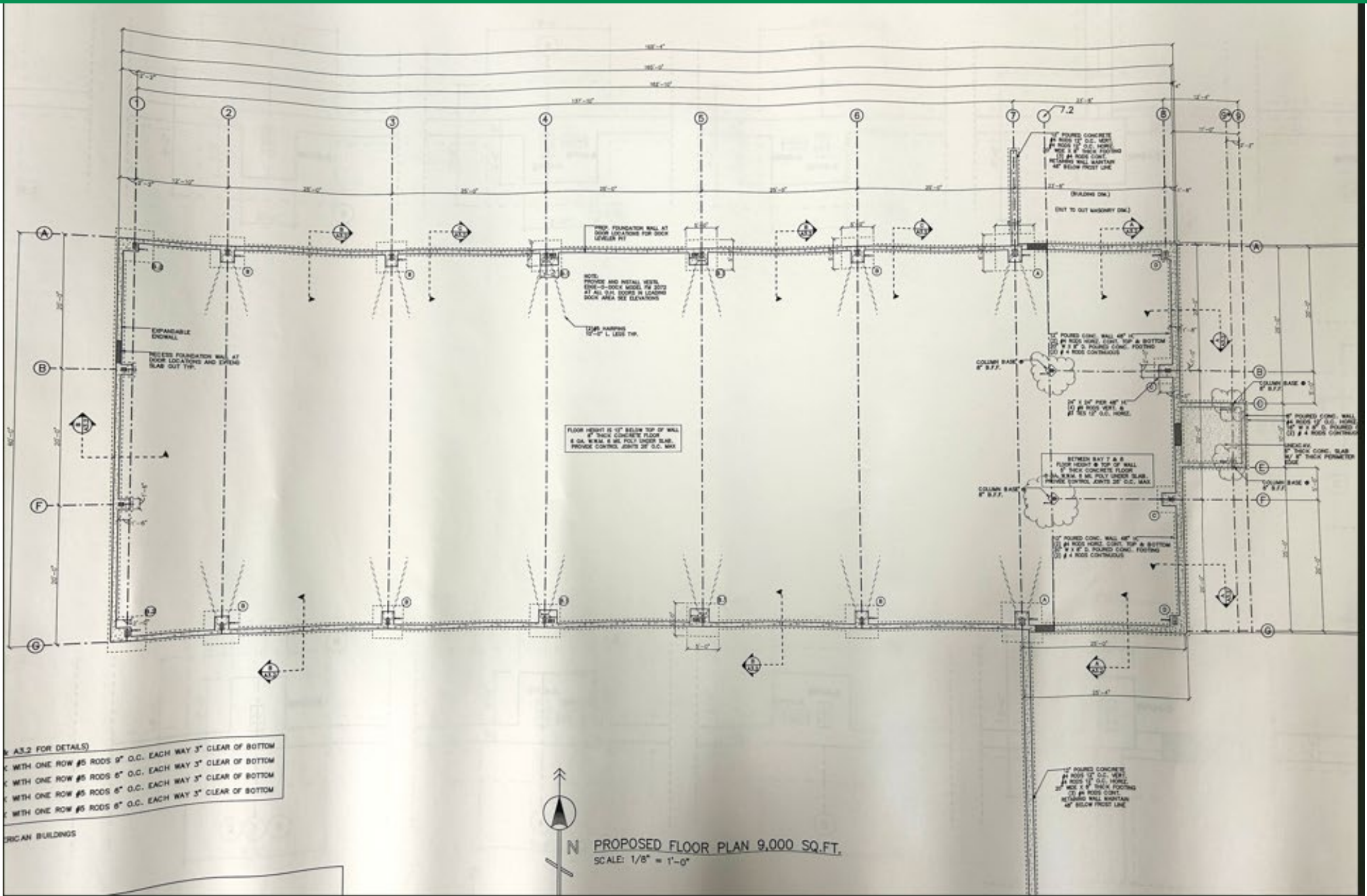

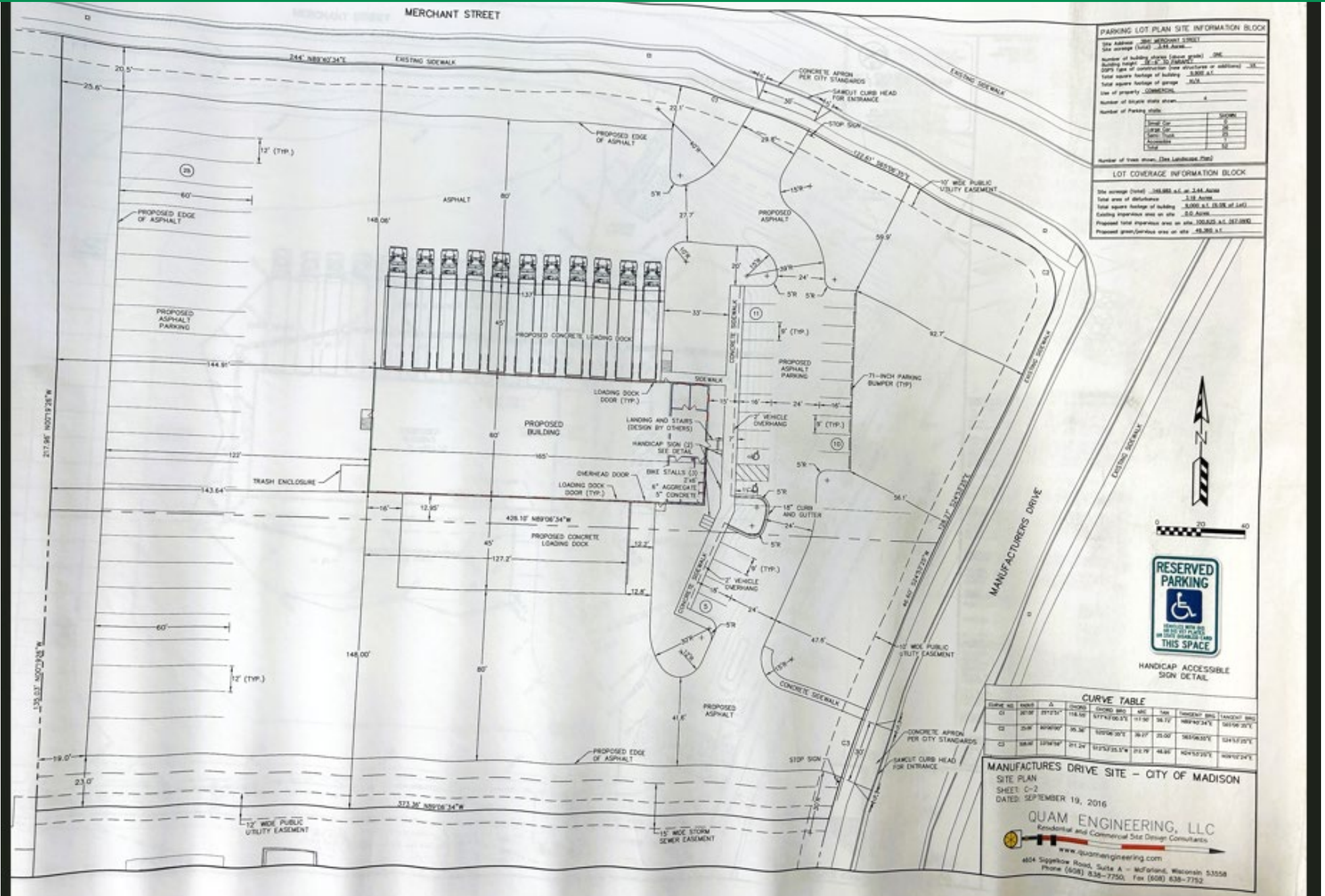
FLOOR PLAN

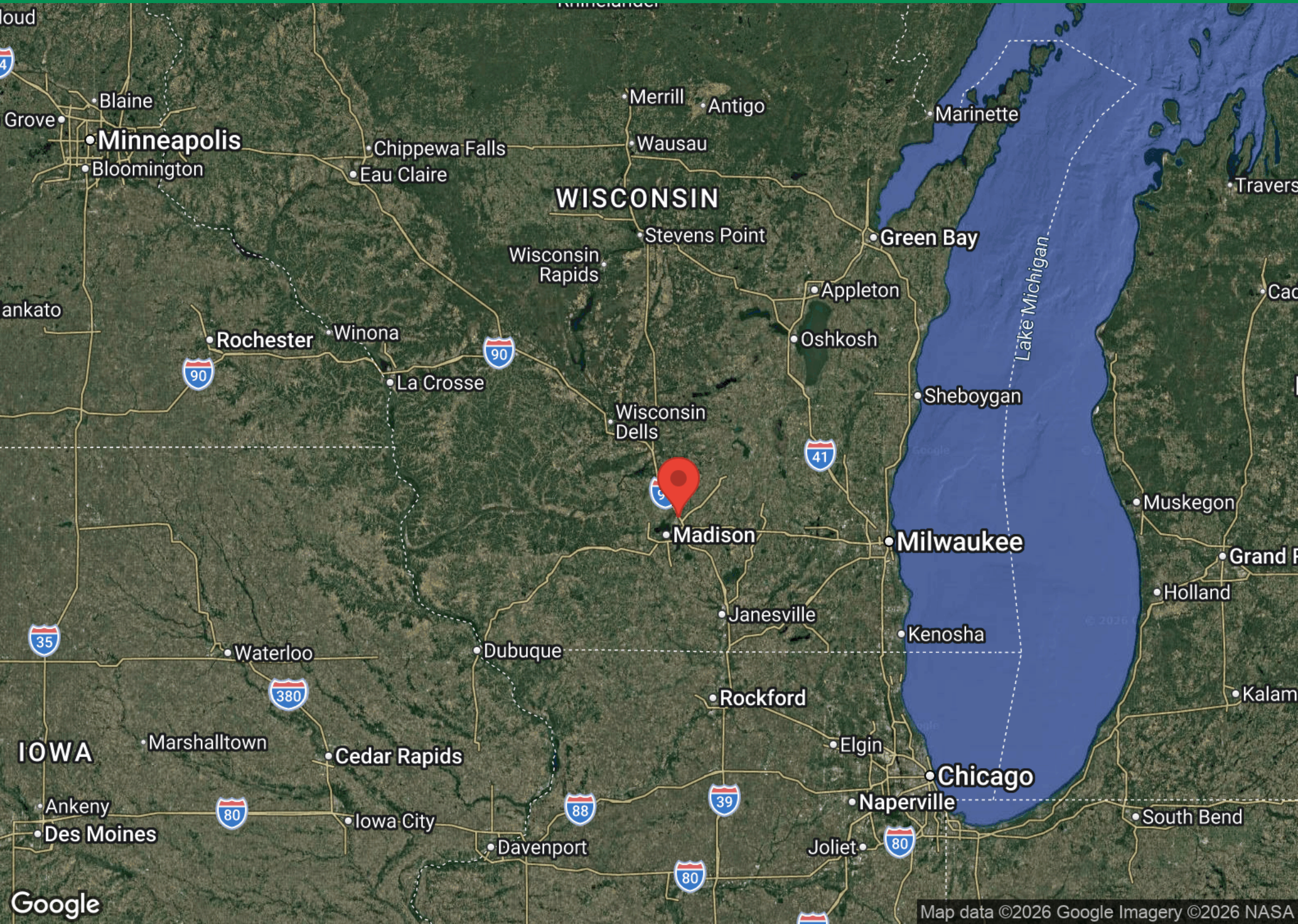

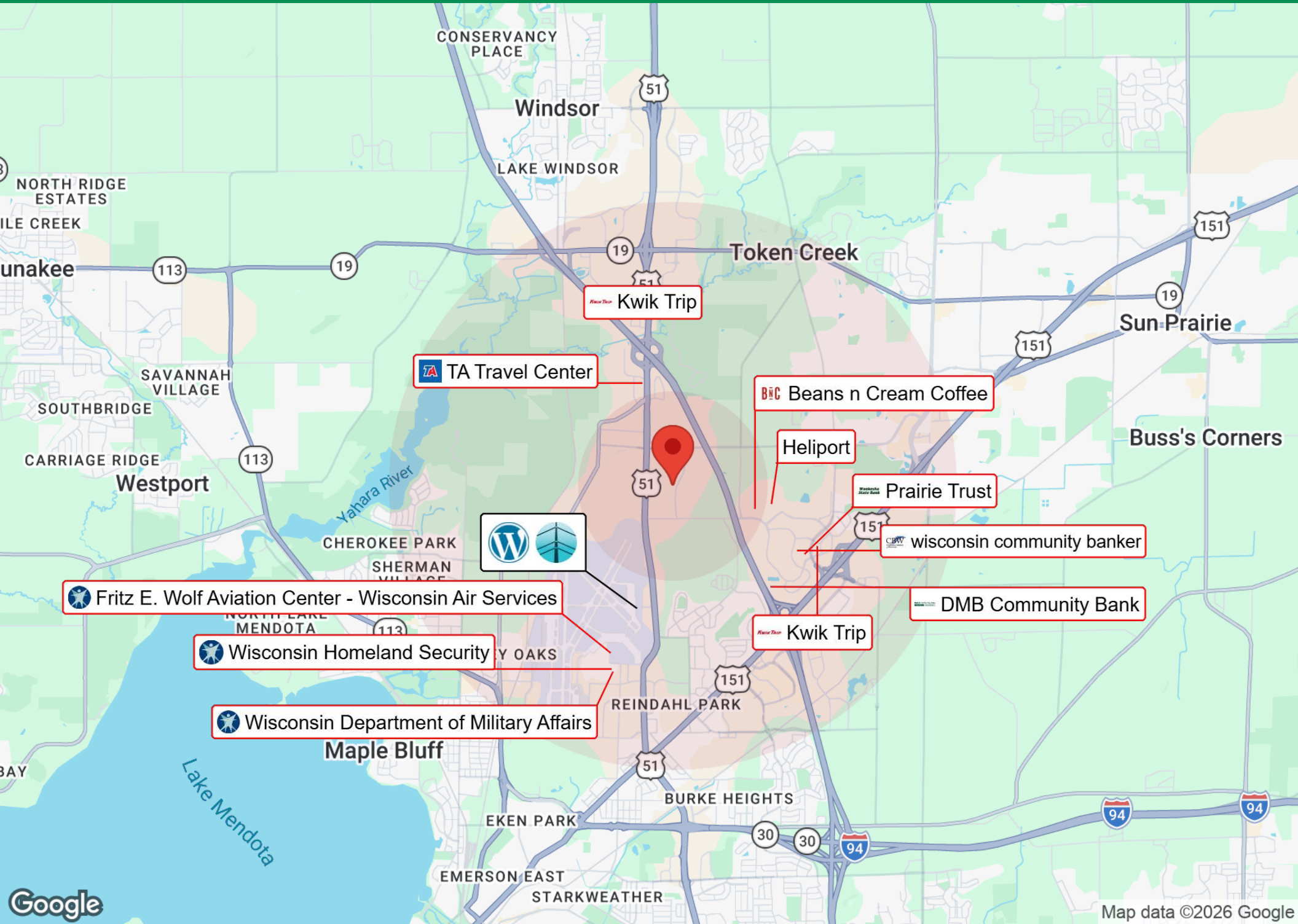
REGIONAL MAP

State of Wisconsin - Disclose to Non-Residential Customers

Prior to negotiating on your behalf the brokerage firm, or an agent associated with the firm, must provide you the following disclosure statement:
