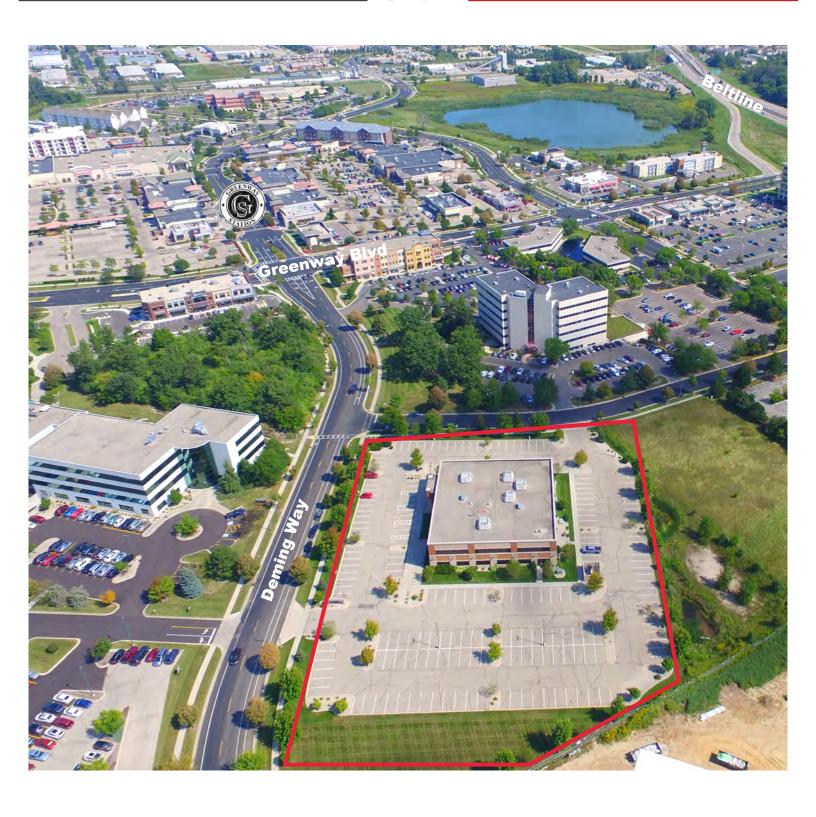

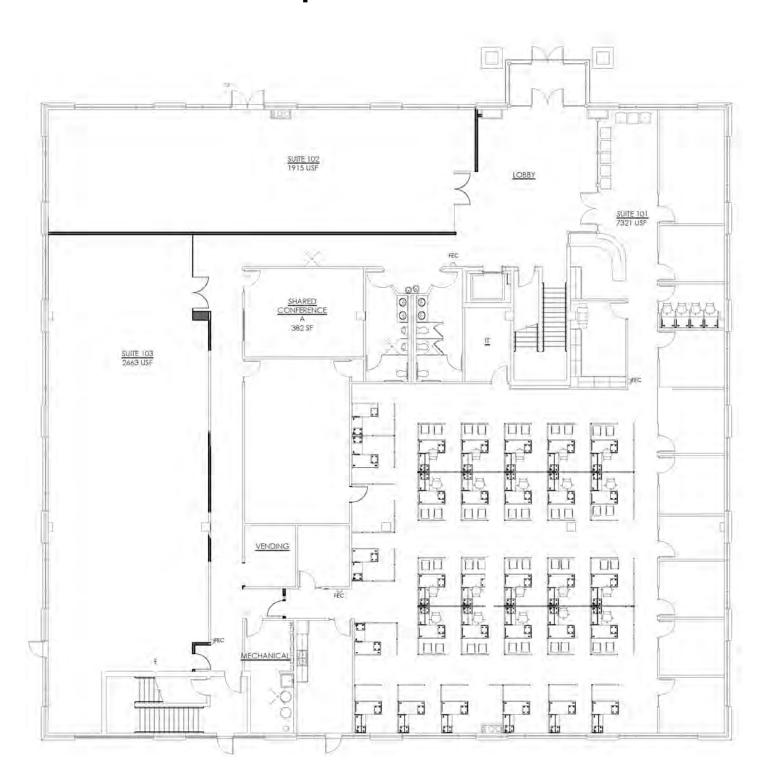

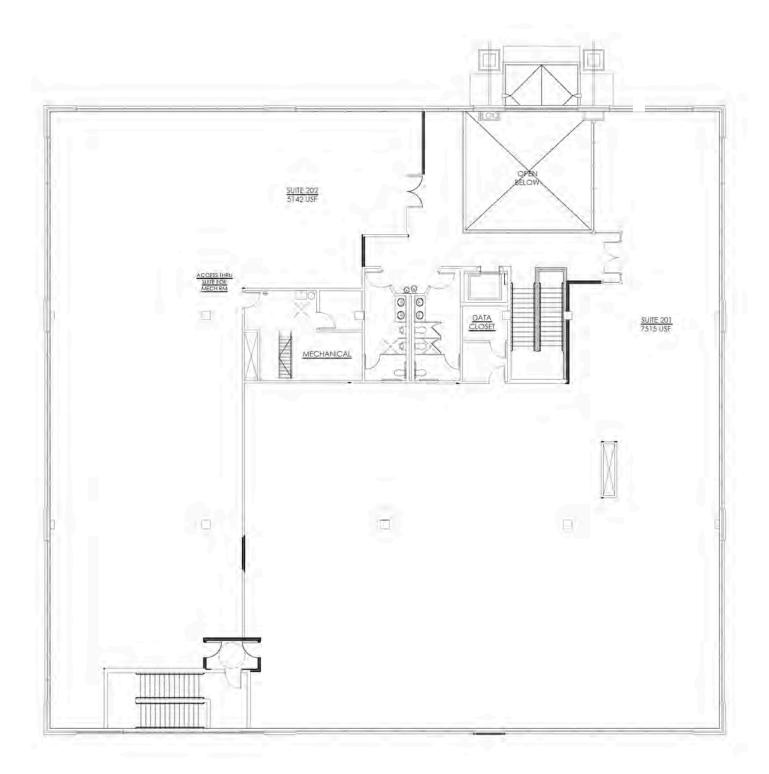
# **Proposed - 1st Floor Plan**

- 15 The duty to safeguard trust funds and other property the broker holds.
- The duty, when negotiating, to present contract proposals in an objective and unbiased manner and disclose the advantages and 17 disadvantages of the proposals.

- 52 that a competent licensee generally recognizes will significantly and adversely affect the value of the property, significantly reduce
- the structural integrity of improvements to real estate, or present a significant health risk to occupants of the property; or information
