### 2 BROKER DISCLOSURE TO CUSTOMERS

- The duty to provide you with accurate information about market conditions within a reasonable time if you request it, unless 9 disclosure of the information is prohibited by law. 10
- 11 The duty to disclose to you in writing certain material adverse facts about a property, unless disclosure of the information is prohibited by law (See Lines 47-55). 12
- 13 The duty to protect your confidentiality. Unless the law requires it, the broker will not disclose your confidential information or the 14 confidential information of other parties (See Lines 22-39).
- 15 The duty to safeguard trust funds and other property the broker holds.
- The duty, when negotiating, to present contract proposals in an objective and unbiased manner and disclose the advantages and 16 17 disadvantages of the proposals.
- 18 Please review this information carefully. A broker or salesperson can answer your questions about brokerage services, but if you
- need legal advice, tax advice, or a professional home inspection, contact an attorney, tax advisor, or home inspector. 19

- A "material adverse fact" is defined in Wis. Stat. § 452.01(5g) as an adverse fact that a party indicates is of such significance, or that 48 49 is generally recognized by a competent licensee as being of such significance to a reasonable party, that it affects or would affect
- 50 the party's decision to enter into a contract or agreement concerning a transaction or affects or would affect the party's decision
- 51 about the terms of such a contract or agreement. An "adverse fact" is defined in Wis. Stat. § 452.01(1e) as a condition or occurrence
- 52 that a competent licensee generally recognizes will significantly and adversely affect the value of the property, significantly reduce
- 53 the structural integrity of improvements to real estate, or present a significant health risk to occupants of the property; or information
- 54 that indicates that a party to a transaction is not able to or does not intend to meet his or her obligations under a contract or 55 agreement made concerning the transaction.
